


How to Install Maple 13 on Mac OS X


Within the **Finder**, click on **GO -> Connect to Server...**

In the **Connect to Server** window, type **smb://10.32.3.33** in the **Server Address** field and click the **Connect** button.



Then type in your network username and password and click **Connect**.

Once you are connected to the server, select the **Maple 13** volume and click **OK**. The Maple 13 volume will appear on your desktop and will open automatically.





Double-click **Maple13Installer.zip** icon to download the installer. Then double-click the **Maple13Macinstaller** application to run the wizard.

 **Please note:** You will need to enter your administrative username and password to install this application when prompted.

If the application does not launch, open the **Mac** folder and you will find the **Maple12MacInstaller** within the **InstData** folder. Double-click the icon to install the application and follow the steps below.


You will see the Maple 13 Installer wizard appear, click the **Next** button, accept the license agreement and click **Next** to continue.



It is important that you select **Network License** when prompted. Otherwise, the application will not work properly and you will need to uninstall and then reinstall. Click **Next** to continue.



Right before the installation begins, the above window will appear. Type **10.32.3.33** in the license server field provided and click **Next**.



Click **Install** to complete the installation. Once installed, click **Done** to close the window. You can then access Maple from the **Applications** folder.
