1. Picking a Subject

- Pick something you know
- Be specific



2. Writing Your Script

- Write out bullet points not a full script
- Keep to the point
- Know your target audience
- Let someone else read it



3. Recording Video

- You need: a camera (obviously), LOTS of light, a clean space, and an assistant.

- Make sure you can see what is important

- Vary your shots
- Do multiple takes
- Go slow

 Make sure your desktop is clean!



4. Audio

- Record in a quiet place
- Speak slowly and enunciate clearly



5. Editing

- Where the magic happens
- Put the clips in order
- Pay attention to the pace
- Add finishing touches
- (transitions/text/whatever)



6. Test!

- Make sure you can follow your own instructions
- Get outside feedback


- Create a new project or work on an existing project.
- Import footage directly from phone







- Click clips to trim, detach audio, change speed, add titles, etc
