# 1. Picking a Subject

- Pick something you know
- Be specific

## 2. Writing Your Script

- Write out bullet points not a full script
- Keep to the point
- Know your target audience
- Let someone else read it



### 3. Recording Video

- You need: a camera (obviously), LOTS of light, a clean space, and an assistant.
- Make sure you can see what is important
- Vary your shots
- Do multiple takes
- Go slow



# Recording Your Screen With QuickTime

- Make sure your desktop is clean!



## 4. Audio

- Record in a quiet place
- Speak slowly and enunciate clearly
- Stay on topic
- Add music (if you want)



## 5. Editing

- Where the magic happens
- Put the clips in order
- Pay attention to the pace
- Add finishing touches
- (transitions/text/whatever)



## 6. Test!

- Make sure you can follow your own instructions
- Get outside feedback

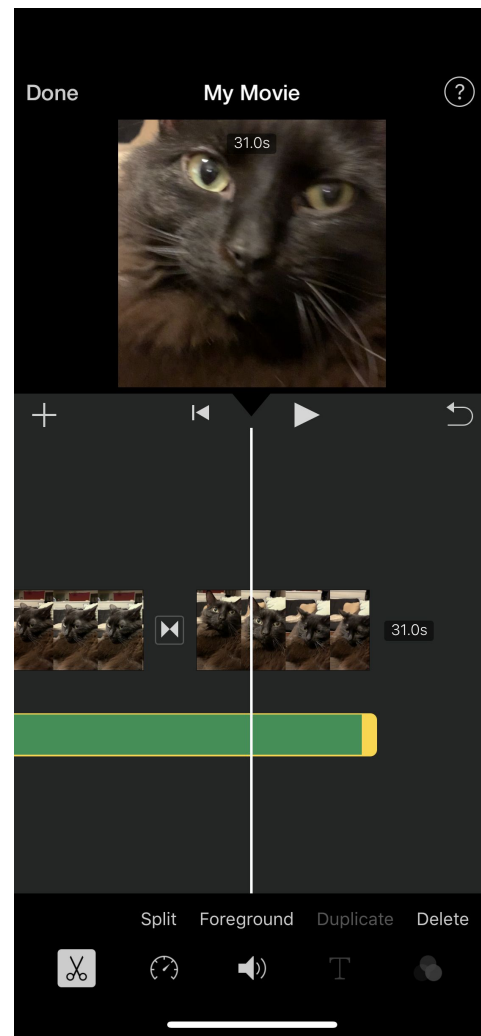
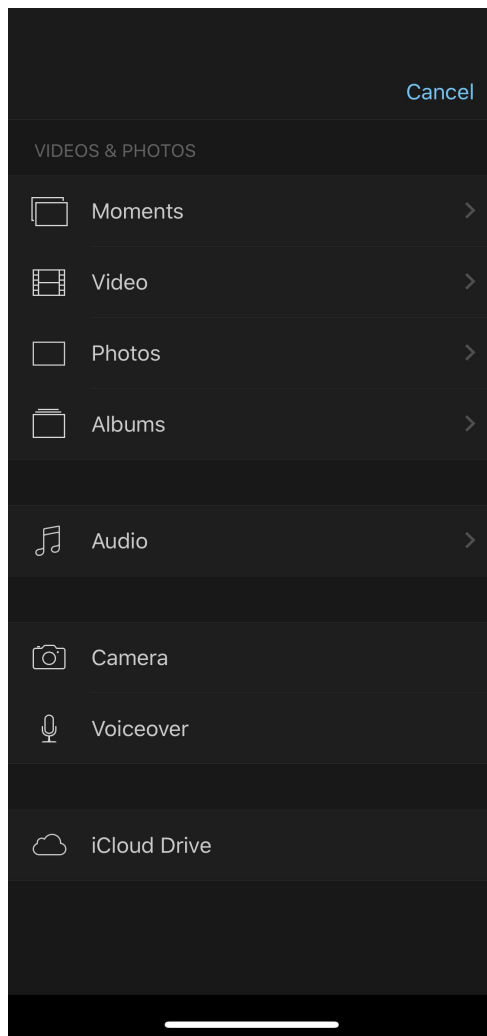
- Create a new project or work on an existing project.

- Click clips to trim, detach audio, change speed, add titles, etc
- Click icon between clips to change transitions



- Click the plus to add additional clips, stills, audio, etc
- Click audio tracks to trim, adjust speed, change volume



- When finished you can title and export your project to wherever you would like.
